

Beginnings 13 4/3/22 Genesis 28, 32

**1.** Kev began his sermon by describing the honeymoon period of faith.

\*\*Do you remember a time, either when you first put your faith in Jesus or when your faith finally became your own, where you had no problem fully trusting God?

\*\*Do you remember a time when life's struggles brought your life crashing down back to earth?

**2.** Read Genesis 32:3-12, which describes how nervous Jacob was to meet Esau. Remember how the two parted ways in Genesis 27:41-42.

\*\*What would you expect this reunion to be like?

For more discussion: Read Genesis 33:1-11

\*\*Based on your previous discussion, what is so shocking about what the reunion actually was like?

\*\*What caused Esau to forgive Jacob?

For even more discussion: Read Genesis 32:23-32.

\*\*What was the purpose of the wrestling? Why did Jacob not give up?

\*\*What is the significance of this story in its context (surrounding it is the story of the reunion of Jacob and Esau)?

**3.** Kev talked in several different ways about the idea that your faith in God should be the highest priority. He said, "Don't take a good thing and make it a God thing," and, "Jesus is not a supplement." This question has been asked in various forms in past discussion guides, but revisit it:

\*\*What have you put ahead of God?

\*\*Since identifying this last time, have you made strides in putting it in its proper perspective?
