3. Read Exodus 3:1-4.

**What other Bible stories take place on mountains next to plants, and how do they relate to each other?

4. Read Exodus 3:14-17, BUT every time you read "The Lord," say instead, "he is." (do that now...) This is what the name of the Lord really means: "He is."

**What is God trying to tell the Israelites through his name?
