

Exodus #3 5/8/22 Exodus 5

- 1. Drew began his sermon by talking about how history rhymes. We see patterns and repetitions of events as they play out. Reflect on your own past.
 - **Are there certain things that you do or that happen to you that seem to keep reoccurring?
- **If you have children, sometimes they behave in certain ways that you don't like, but they are only imitating you. What patterns have you seen in your own life (maybe from your parents or children) that you would like to stop with you?
- **2.** Think about the salvation that God has provided for us, and how he rescued the people from slavery in Egypt.
 - **Why did God rescue the Israelites (some reasons can be found in Exodus 1-2)?
 - **How does this relate to the salvation through Jesus?

For further discussion: One of Drew's main points was that God rescued the Israelites *so that* they could worship him (read Exodus 5:1).

- **Why does God want to be worshipped?
- **Was the original plan for the Israelites to come back to Egypt after celebrating this feast?
- **3.** Watch the video about the name of God linked on the Greater Story Resources website.
 - **What was interesting to you about the video?
 - **Since it seems logical that God picked his name, why did he pick that one?
 - **What implications can you draw about God's character from the name of God?
 - **Do you think we should use the name, "Yahweh" more, the same, or less? Why?
